2019	Vine Roots Garnacha Blanca, <i>Rioja</i> <i>Judicious use of oak adds vanilla and sweet spice to fresh pink grapefruit tropical notes</i>	Organic, VG	39
2020	Bourgogne Blanc des Jacobins, Louis Jadot, <i>Burgundy</i> <i>Almonds and lime fruit aromas lead to deliciously complex rich, buttery flavours and a long finish</i>	V	48
2017	Dr. Konstantin Frank Gewürztraminer, <i>Finger Lakes, USA</i> <i>Powerful Turkish delight and lychees aromas. The palate adds fresher red fruits and wet slate to temper the aromatics</i>		55
2019	Sancerre, Domaine de Terres Blanches, <i>Loire Valley</i> <i>Lively green fruit and elderflower flavours, touches of minerality and orange rind, whilst six months ageing on the fine lees has added a creamy textural quality and touches of biscuit</i>	VG	64
2017	Chablis 1er Cru Montmain, J. Moreau et Fils, <i>Burgundy</i> <i>Distinct ripeness lends a lean and racy character to the wine with mouth-watering hints of green apple, ginger, pan-fried chestnuts and a long, steely finish</i>	VG	81

2018	Puligny-Montrachet, Remoissenet Père & Fils, <i>Burgundy</i> <i>From the most famous white wine vineyard in the Côte D'Or. The nose shows minerality and fruit with a spine of spicy oak. Rich, complex flavours of hawthorn blossom, red apple and pear</i>	VG	140
2017	Hermitage Blanc, Chante-Alouette, Chapoutier, <i>Rhône</i> <i>A weighty wine that never loses its style and elegance. Complex aromas of quince, walnut, honey, ginger and acacia. The palate has depth with more smoky fruit and quite simply incredible length</i>	Organic, VG	160

2019	Vavasour Pinot Noir, <i>Awatere Valley, New Zealand</i> <i>Forest fruits and white flower aromas. A superb palate balancing red fruit, depth and freshness</i>	V	41

2017	The Black Angus Cabernet Sauvignon, <i>Victoria, Australia</i> <i>The very epitome of Australian Cabernet - big and rich with classic cassis, eucalyptus, and cedar aroma. It is very full-bodied and complex with more brambly fruit and swathes of dark chocolate</i>	VG	73
2017	Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Clos de L'Oratoire des Papes, Ogier, <i>Rhône</i> <i>Shows luscious dark fruit, anise spice, field mushroom and surprising floral notes on the nose. It is nicely full and rich with intense flavours of blackberry, plum and a touch of garrigues herb</i>	Organic, VG	88
2014	Barolo, Cru Ravera Lo Zoccolao, Domini Villa Lanata, <i>Piemonte, Italy</i> <i>Both the nose and the palate are dominated by violets, cedar wood, cigar box and red fruit. It is very full-bodied and brooding but surprisingly fresh and drinkable for such a massive wine</i>		110
2016	Mas La Plana, Torres, <i>Penedès, Spain</i> <i>One of Spain's truly iconic wines. Aromas of morello cherry and blueberry lead onto a dynamic broad palate with plenty of dark fruit, allspice and cinnamon. The finish is incredibly long and profound</i>	VG	125
2016	Cornas, Les Ruchets, Jean-Luc Colombo, <i>Rhône</i> <i>Made from 100% Syrah, it offers a bouquet of sweet cherry, blackcurrant, white pepper and roasted nuts whilst the palate is stylish and structured. A legendary wine.</i>	VG	140
2013	Château d'Issan 3ème Cru Classé, <i>Margaux, Bordeaux</i> <i>Grand Cru in the 1855 Classification. It shows strong black fruit and creamy notes on the nose followed on by weighty flavours of cassis, dark chocolate, black cherry, tobacco. Intense and lengthy</i>	V	170
